Notices are posted throughout all of the venues explaining that photography and video recording are happening, and if you don't consent to your image and likeness being captured and used, you should avoid the area

The signage on entry to the venues is as follows

By entering and by your presence here, you consent to be photographed, filmed and/or otherwise recorded. Your entry constitutes your consent to such photography, filming and/or recording and to any use, in any and all media throughout the universe in perpetuity, of your appearance, voice and name for any purpose whatsoever in connection with the production presently entitled: Oz Kink Fest / Fetish Expo / Fetish Expo After Party / Hellfire Resurrection

You understand that all photography, filming and/or recording will be done in reliance on this consent given by you by entering this area.

If you do not agree to the foregoing, please do not enter this area/venue.

If you raise your hand to your face we will immediately delete any photos.

On average at a large event we take 200 images from our official photographers of which 80% are of the performances and the rest posed consenting attendees there is no over use of cameras/video as we realise that you come to our events for a good time and we respect your privacy
